### ELECTRIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RIDER

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Economic Development Rider (EDR) is to encourage industrial and commercial development and thereby increase economic development opportunities in the City's service area.

### **AVAILABILITY**

Electric service under this Rider is available to certain customers otherwise qualified for service under the City's electric power rates for Primary Metering Service that also meet the criteria stated herein on a first come, first serve basis as determined by the execution of the contract specified herein. The availability of this Rider shall be limited to qualified customers not involved in selling or providing goods and services directly to the general public. The City will consider all requests for service under this Rider; however, requests will not be accepted for new or expanded facilities built, installed, under construction or otherwise committed to operation prior to March 1, 2019. Electric service under this Rider is not available in conjunction with service provided pursuant to any other special contract agreements.

### **APPLICABILITY**

Sufficiently detailed information shall be provided by the Customer to enable the City to determine whether a facility is qualified for the Rider. Service under this Rider shall be evidenced by a contract between the Customer and the City substantially in the form included herewith.

### **CRITERIA**

Upon the election of the Customer and acceptance by the City, as evidenced by fully executed contract, the provisions of this Rider are applicable to new industrial customers and to the new facilities of existing industrial customers who expand operations and who meet the following criteria:

- Annual kW Demand Criterion: The peak demand (over a fifteen (15) minute period) of the new customer or additional facilities is reasonably projected to be at least five hundred (500) kW within two (2) years of the new customer or separately measured/metered facilities expansion first receiving service from City. The new or expanding customer and City will mutually agree upon a capacity expansion plan to be defined in the electric service agreement.
- 2. Load Factor Criterion: The annual load factor of the new customer or additional facilities is reasonably projected to exceed fifty-five percent (55%) within two (2) years of the new customer or additional separately measured facilities commencing service under this Rider. The customer must maintain an annual load factor exceeding fifty-five percent (55%) or greater in years three (3) through five (5) of the contract to continue to be eligible under this Rider. The customer's annual load factor will be reviewed every twelve (12) months on the anniversary of the commencement date of service pursuant to this Rider. Failure to meet this requirement will disqualify the Customer for service under this Rider effective the end of the twelve (12) month period in which such requirement was not met.

The annual load factor of the customer shall be determined by the following relationship:

Annual Energy (kWh)/Hours in Year Maximum (peak) Annual Demand

#### ELECTRIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RIDER

The maximum (peak) annual demand is defined as the actual measured demand of the new Customer or facilities during a fifteen (15) minute period during the year.

3. The new or additional facility must also be approved as recipient of local, regional or state governmental economic development incentives at the time the EDR agreement becomes effective.

### INCENTIVE PROVISIONS

- 1. <u>Rate Discount:</u> Prior to taxes, each of the Customer's net bills for qualifying service, calculated in accordance with the Primary Metering rate schedule, will be discounted by thirty percent (30%) for service during the first (1<sup>st</sup>) contract year, twenty-five percent (25%) for service during the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) contract year, twenty percent (20%) for service during the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) contract year, fifteen percent (15%) for service during the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) year, and ten percent (10%) for service during the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) contract year. After the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) contract year, this incentive provision shall cease.
- 2. <u>Minimum Bill:</u> The minimum monthly bill will be the charge for the minimum monthly Premise Demand Charge at five hundred (500) kW pursuant to the Primary Metering rate schedule. Other provisions of the Primary Metering rate schedule also apply. After the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) contract year, this provision shall cease.
- Local Service Facilities: The City will not require an additional facilities charge or line extension charge
  for facilities installed to serve the customer if the City's analysis of expected revenues from the new
  load on an ongoing basis is determined to be sufficient to justify the required investment in the
  facilities.
- 4. <u>Separately Measure Service</u>: Qualifying service must be separately metered or sub-metered from service to other facilities.
- 5. Shifting of Existing Load: For Customers with existing facilities at one (1) or more locations in the City's service area, this Rider shall not be applicable to service provided at any other delivery point prior to Customer receiving service under this Rider. Customer is prohibited from shifting loads from those locations already existing in the City's service area to qualify for this Rider or to receive benefits from this Rider.

### LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

Subject to ten percent (10%) late payment charge per thirty (30) day period (or portion thereof) if not paid by the date shown on the bill.

<u>Class 2 User</u> - Any school, place of business, church, multi-dwelling residence, industry, office or multi-office building which receives all of its water from the city water system and discharges only normal domestic sewage to the sewer system and whose total monthly water consumption does not exceed 5,000 gallons.

<u>Class 3 User</u> - Any school, place of business, church, multi-dwelling residence, industry, office or multi-office building which receives all of its water from the city water system and discharges only normal domestic sewage to the sewer system and whose total monthly water consumption does not exceed 20,000 gallons.

<u>Class 4 User</u> - Any school, place of business, church, multi-dwelling residence, industry, office or multi-office building which receives all of its water from the city water system and discharges only normal domestic sewage to the sewer system and whose total monthly water consumption does not exceed 100,000 gallons.

<u>Class 5 User</u> - Any school, place of business, church, multi-dwelling residence, industry, office or multi-office building which receives all of its water from the city water system and discharges only normal domestic sewage to the sewer system and whose total monthly water consumption exceeds 100,000 gallons.

<u>Class 6 User</u> - Any user who discharges anything other than normal domestic wastewater to the sewer system.

<u>Class 7 User</u> - Any user who receives his water from a source other than city water supply system and discharges only normal domestic sewage to the sewer system.

<u>Class 8 User</u> - Any user who receives part of his water from the city water system and the remainder of his water from another source or any user who allows rainwater, surface water or ground water to enter the sewer system from his property and who otherwise discharges only normal domestic sewage to the sewer system.

Class 9 User - Any user whose sewage is produced outside of and transported into the city sewer system.

## LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

There will be no penalty on sewer charges.

Sewer charges will be deleted where water is used for sprinkling, industrial processes and non-sanitary uses if metered so as to determine water used that is not discharged into the city's sanitary sewer system.
